

It is hereby enlightened that the Department of Sociology had organized One-day Menstrual Hygiene Campaign in collaboration with Women Cell of the College at The Trinity Public School, Mongshangei on 20 December, 2022.

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the campaign was to impart the insights of menstrual hygiene to (non)menstruating girls as well as boys of Class VI students of the school. Furthermore, it was conducted to impart the social paradigm associated with menstrual hygiene specifically. Another focus of the campaign was to contribute to the local development of the area through the school at the college level.

ITINERARY:

The Faculties of the Department of Sociology had searched high and low to seek for government schemes and booklet. We were successful in our attempt to achieve the above. Through the information acquired from Department of Social Welfare, Government of Manipur we were able to provide sanitary pad and a booklet to each student of Class VI. It was also presented to the staffs of the school. The sanitary pads were acquired through Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendra from Chingmeirong, Khongnang, Ani Karak at a subsidized rate. The booklet was acquired from We TheChange at Mantripukhri. Both the products were collected personally by the faculty members of the Department.

On the day of the campaign, the teachers and students of the college were welcomed by the Principal and staffs of the Trinity Pubic School. The Awareness speeches were delivered bilingually by two of faculty members respectively. They were Pangambam Sophia Devi and Elena Heisnam, Assistant Professors of the Department of Sociology. More than 170 people graced the campaign. 113 students of Class VI, the Principal of the school and their teaching and non-teaching staffs, faculty members from other departments of our college, IQAC members, members of the Women cell, faculty members of our Department as well as students of the college were in attendance. The Head of Department of Department of Sociology presented a small token of appreciation to the Principal of the school. The campaign was closed with the distribution of sanitary pads, booklets and refreshments to the people in attendance.
