The programme was graced by IAS officer, Mrs. Pooja Elangbam as Chief Guest. Ksh. Devendra and Oinam Swarnalata Devi graced the function as Guest of Honours and it was presided by the Principal, Th. Nandita Devi.

The programme was attended by faculty members and students of the college. The function started after 1:00 pm on arrival of the chief guest Mrs. Pooja Elangbam. An IAS officer of the UPSC cadre Mrs. Pooja Elangbam is a famous personality amongst the youths of Manipur since her selection as IAS officer in the year 2016. She started her speech on how women can fight for their rights and how they can be empowered. 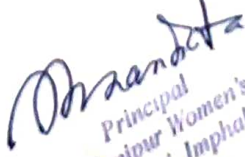
