

Indian Knowledge System (IKS) is a complex and ever evolving system of knowledge. The system went through a long passage of time and hence, the knowledge system has been enriched in different historical epoch. This system of knowledge is well integrated in different modern disciplines and is playing a vital role in understanding the realities.

In order to understand the realities holistically, the IKS should be given its due value. For respecting and locating the Indian Knowledge System in education and curriculum, it is necessary to impart the knowledge of the System to all the faculty members and academia. Keeping this in mind, the short course on Indian Knowledge System is proposed to be organized by our College.

#### **Objectives of the Course**

The Course aims to attain the following objectives

1. To understand the basic structure of Indian Knowledge System
2. To know how Indian Knowledge System is expressed in different disciplines, ranging from natural sciences to medical sciences to social sciences
3. To explore how Indian Knowledge System evolves to modern Indian thoughts and theories in different disciplines

#### **Format of the Course**


The nature of the Course will be mainly lecture and interaction mode. Invited speakers who are experts in the given themes will deliver lectures and the lectures will be followed by interactions. There will be 20 lectures on different themes and sub-themes. Each lecture will take 90 minutes including the interaction. At the end of the Course, there will be sessions for academic paper presentations on relevant areas by the participants. On the basis of the presentation, the participants will be evaluated.

The main themes of the Course are given below:

1. Thought, Theories and Practices: Indian Tradition
2. Indian Knowledge System: Roots and Evolution
3. Indian Concepts of Man and Nature
4. Ancient Indian Thoughts
5. Ayurveda Principles
6. Indian Psychological Perspectives
7. Ancient Indian Mathematics
8. Modern Indian Thinkers: Convergence and Divergences vis-à-vis Indian Knowledge System
9. Synthesis of Different Traditions of Idea in India
10. Modern education and necessity of Indian Knowledge System

#### **Eligibilities of the participants**
